

## Ingratitude

- Lk. 17:11-19
  - Leprosy incurable at this time
  - Lev. 13:45-46 – OT law for lepers to quarantine outside camp
  - Leprosy:body – sin:heart
  - Show yourselves to the priest – all 10 healed
  - Only 1 returned to thank Jesus
- OT example
  - Israel – Often ungrateful toward God, despite saving them multiple times, Dt. 32:15
- Many are ungrateful today
  - Children – often don't thank parents, others for various things
  - Flag/veterans – “thank you for your service”
  - Teachers – whether at school, workplace, or church, often not recognized adequately
  - Leaders in church – have you thanked them for teaching/helping you on your path to Christ?
  - Church – Are we thankful for it and our brethren? Or do we criticize more often than not?
- More importantly...
  - God – Rom. 1:21; Jm. 1:17
  - Jesus – Has extended healing power to us, cleansing us from our sins. Do we return to thank Him?
    - Some flatly reject Him
    - Some never study to see what He requires
